Located on the lower stretch of this Canadian Heritage River, the 190-hectare park offers three boat launches into the Grand. The picnic area includes a large swimming pool, sand volleyball courts and playgrounds. Food and boat concessions add to our visitors' enjoyment. Serviced, unserviced and riverfront campsites are available.
