About the park

Pinehurst Lake is a 193 hectare (477 acre) park with a nine hectare (23 acre) spring-fed kettle lake that was formed during the last ice age. The lake provides great swimming, fishing, ice fishing and canoeing. Camp at over 230 serviced or unserviced, radio-free campsites.

The park also features nine km of hiking trails, some winding through spectacular examples of Carolinian forest. In winter, the trails are popular for snowshoeing.

Camping, fishing, hiking or boating, our parks are as close as your own backyard.

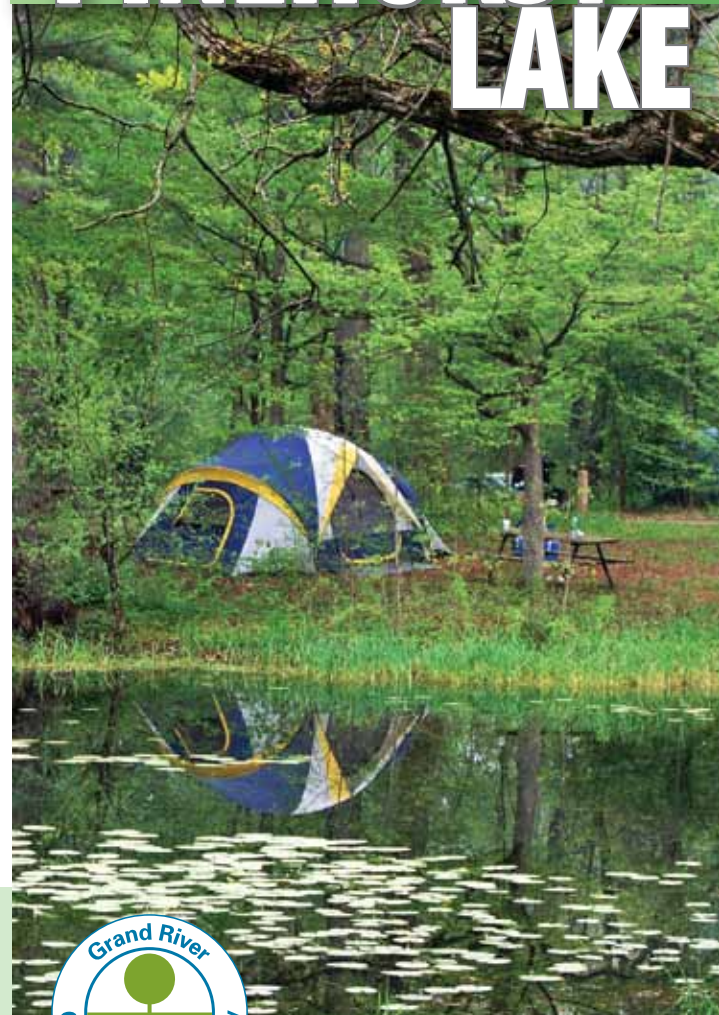
Pinehurst Lake features nine kilometres of hiking trails.
