



Luther Marsh Boat Registration Form

- All visitors must enter and register at the main gate - daily user fees or seasons passes are required.
- All boaters are required to fill out the boat registration form below and place it face up in their vehicle's windshield.
- A picnic area is at the main entrance - all garbage must be carried out of the park or put in containers at the main entrance.
- Non-motorized watercraft including canoes, kayaks and rowboats are permitted on the marsh between July 31st and September 1st after which interior roads are open to motor vehicles and motorboats are permitted with a maximum allowable HP of 25.
- Fishing is permitted outside of the sanctuary areas.
- Only perch, bullhead and minnows can be found in the lake.
- Camping is not permitted in the area.
- No open fires are permitted in the area.
- Dogs must be kept on a leash in closed hunting seasons and on closed hunting days.
- All motor vehicles are restricted to seasonally open interior roads - unlicensed off-road vehicles are not permitted in the area.
- Alcohol is prohibited at all times.
- All persons agree not to enter Wildlife Sanctuaries and to observe all rules and regulations of the Grand River Conservation Authority

CAUTION IS ADVISED - Luther Lake is shallow, weedy, and full of stumps.
